Tips & Tricks—Customized Shortcut Keys

Customized Shortcut Keys

A shortcut key in Windows XP/Win7 is a key, or combination of keys, pressed to perform a specific action instead of performing said action with the mouse.

For example, you can set "I" as Internet Explorer's shortcut key and then press "CTRL," "ALT" and "I" at the same time to open IE instead of choosing it through the start menu or an icon.

To do this trick you simply need to right-click a program under the start menu's "All Programs" list and click

"Properties." If the option is available, there will be a tab labelled "Shortcut" with a text box for entering your chosen letter.

By default it says NONE enter letter in box, you will see eg (alt + ctrl + I) then apply and ok, to use shortcut, hold down alt, ctrl keys and press letter chosen "I"
